

Y Central - COVID Update April 2022

The Y is and has always been about inclusivity and we look forward to re-opening the doors to everyone.

From Tuesday 5th April everyone will be able to enter our sites without having to show their vaccine pass, scan or sign in.

However, to protect the safety of other all, masks will still be required indoors, in line with the current government guidance. We are also asking everyone to maintain safe distances from one and other, and of course stay at home if unwell. Some programmes will still limit access and/or continue sign in/sign out from entry points to reduce risk to those most vulnerable.

We continue to manage the impacts of Omicron on our workforce, which means there will be reduced services or temporary closures at some locations from time to time. We do apologise in advance.

From Tuesday 5 April 2022 being fully vaccinated will be strongly encouraged among YMCA Central employees but will no longer be a requirement in order for our people to carry out their roles and access our workplaces, apart from in certain circumstances, like when a government mandate is in place.

In line with this new approach and the government's changes, customers accessing our programmes and facilities will no longer need to provide evidence of a My Vaccine Pass, however, current protocols for picking up/dropping off kids may remain.
